

### 1.3.1 W3C - Recommendations

Recommendations: liable documents describing technical standards for the Web.

Review procedure:

- *Working Drafts*: technical notes, several working draft states possible, not liable
- After several reviews on working drafts within interest group and working group: *Candidate Recommendations*, still not liable
- After repeated, public review: *Proposed Recommendation*
- After final review: *Recommendation*
- Recommendation: versioned, e.g. HTML 4.01, CSS 2.0, XML 1.0, etc.
- New version of a recommendation requires new review procedure.
- All recommendations of W3C available via <http://www.w3.org/TR/>

### 1.4 Other Standards: RFCs: Request for Comments

- Internet standards, not specific to WWW
- Organized by Internet Engineering Task Force (IETF) <http://www.ietf.org>
